
GlengarryHats.com Doublet Measurement Advice

Take these measurements while wearing your kilt, a good fitting dress shirt, and the belt you will be wearing on the outside of the tunic.



NECK

Puff out your neck to it's maximum size before measuring. Collar will be cut 1" larger than provided measurement to ensure your collar will be comfortable in all conditions.

CHEST

Measure chest circumference under arms at largest point. Chest will be cut about 1" larger than provided measurement.

WAIST

Measure waist circumference <u>over your kilt</u> at the level you will be wearing your belt on the outside of the tunic. Waist will be cut about 1" larger than provided measurement. Always measure, absolutely **DO NOT USE YOUR TROUSER WAIST SIZE!**

FRONT LENGTH

Measure from the base of your collar to the bottom of your belt while wearing the belt at the level you will be wearing it on the outside of the tunic. Your belt level on the outside of the tunic may be different that when wearing your belt with kilt and shirt alone (usually higher). The belt hooks will be installed at this level.

BACK LENGTH

Measure from the base of your collar to the bottom of your belt.

SLEEVE

Measure from top seam where shirt arm attaches to your shirt body over bent elbow to the desired cuff length. Note cuffs normally "ride up" a little when bending your arm, so it is important to measure with a bent elbow to get desired wrist coverage when bending your arms while wearing your tunic. Compare with same measurement from a good fitting suit jacket.

SHOULDER WIDTH

Measure from shoulder seam to shoulder seam while wearing a good fitting dress shirt.
